Laurel Leaves – The Laurel leaves represent the fourteen states of Korea and the advancement of peace. The laurel leaves complete a circle to ensure peace and humility has no end.



The Three Seeds – Joined to the Laurel leaves on each side represents the 'three thousand Li' this is the distance running North to the South of the 'Land of Morning Calm' and its success.

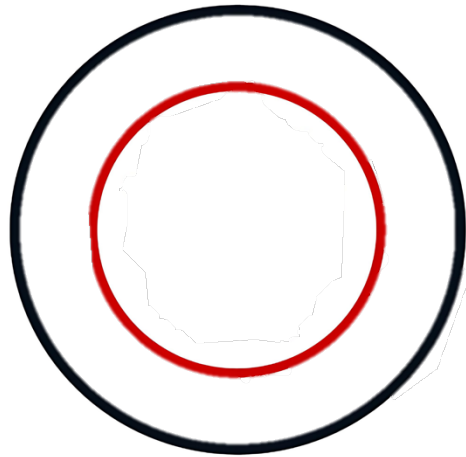


The Six Seeds – The six seeds in total indicate the world and represent the six continents.



White Background – The White background represents purity and uniformity. It is the cycle of reaching Midnight Blue belt and returning to White belt

Blue and Red Bands – The Blue and Red combined on the badge represents the Masters belt. The Blue on its own represents the Ocean and Dan grades.



Korean Lettering – Represents Tang Soo Do Moo Duk Kwan
